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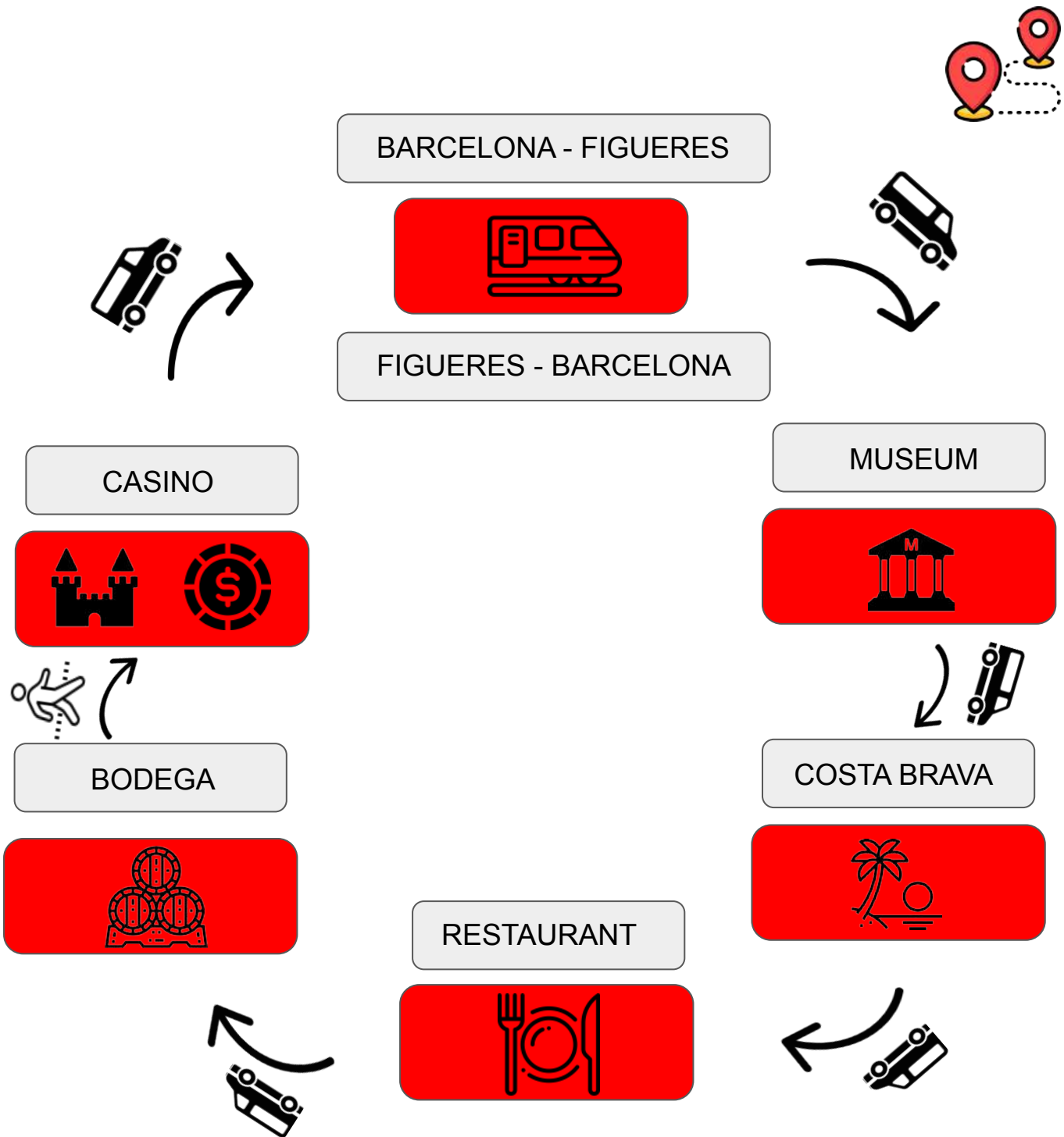
Empordà Experience - ALL DAY

Transport Barcelona - Figueres (50 min)

The AVE high speed train is an excellent option to travel from Barcelona to Figueres. The trip takes about an hour, and there are several trains departing throughout the day.

In Barcelona, you can take the AVE at the Barcelona Sants train station, which is the main station in the city and has connections to several public transport lines. Barcelona Sants train station is located at Plaza dels Països Catalans, s/n, 08014 Barcelona.



Customers will have to take the AVE high speed train from Barcelona to Figueres where a minibus will pick them up to take them to the winery.
